This disproportionate access to quality-of-life indicators such as mentorship, financial literacy, and leadership development opportunities reflects profound inequities that continually contribute to disparities in academic achievement, economic mobility, emotional well-being, and long-term career readiness. These quality-of-life indicator gaps have long-term effects that negatively impact communities for decades, or even generations to come. Without early, consistent intervention and supportive networks, these challenges often compound over time.

For nearly a decade, Girls on a Mission with Ambition has worked to close these gaps by providing educational workshops, meaningful experiences, resources, enrichment programs, mentorship, and empowerment conferences to enhance the lives of motivated, high-achieving young women from low-income households in New Jersey. To date, more than 650 girls (ages 10-18) have participated in our programs, with 100% graduating from high school, 90% pursuing higher education, and 75% reporting increased mental health awareness and resilience skills.

By providing programs targeted at strengthening skills related to quality-of-life outcomes, Girls on a Mission with Ambition empowers young women to recognize their potential and lead with confidence, ambition, and purpose. This progress is only possible through a committed community of partners.

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## Mission:

To mentor, empower, and educate young girls and women residing in urban and at-risk communities. Our mission is to provide access to resources and engage young girls in life-sustaining teachings and skills needed to become productive leaders within their communities.

## Our Story:

Founded in 2018 by Scarlette Gaudin, Girls on a Mission with Ambition was created with the understanding that when girls of color are seen, supported, and empowered, their possibilities are limitless. After years of mentoring youth across urban communities in New Jersey and Pennsylvania, Gaudin witnessed the transformative power of guidance, encouragement, and mentorship as girls with underdeveloped confidence and limited resources grew into confident, purpose-driven young women. She also saw the immense challenges faced by hardworking families striving to provide for their children without access to the time, funding, or opportunities needed to fully invest in their potential. In response, Gaudin brought together a dynamic team of women united by a shared commitment to equity, mentorship, impact, and sisterhood. Girls on a Mission with Ambition was formed to provide education, meaningful experiences, resources, and opportunities to women and girls in need through enrichment programs, mentorship, educational workshops and empowerment conferences.

## About Girls on a Mission with Ambition:

Girls on a Mission with Ambition is a privately funded 501c3 nonprofit organization committed to uplifting and equipping high-achieving, low-income young women in underserved communities. Through four evidence-informed programs, the organization addresses critical quality-of-life indicators linked to long-term academic, social, and economic success, including self-efficacy, cultural engagement and identity development, resilience and coping skills, leadership capacity, mental health and emotional well-being, financial literacy, and access to sustained mentorship. Programs are designed to produce measurable outcomes that ensure participants are supported holistically and prepared to thrive academically, socially, and economically.

# Programming

Through evidence-based and community-centered programming, Girls on a Mission with Ambition addresses the disproportionate access to quality-of-life resources faced by young women residing in at risk/urban communities. These resources include mentorship, financial literacy, and leadership development opportunities.

## BEYOU: EMPOWERMENT INITIATIVE

The BeYOU Empowerment Initiative builds confidence and self-acceptance in girls through educational workshops led by educators, entrepreneurs, and community leaders. Programming focuses on critical life skills, including mental health awareness, self-esteem development, and financial literacy.

The conference also offers affirmation-centered experiences—such as creative expression stations, a confidence-building runway showcase, and an Affirmation Sister Circle—that encourage peer support, self-expression, and positive identity development in a safe, supportive environment. In 2025, we had 130+ girls in attendance for the empowerment conference.

## CAREER READINESS

The Career Readiness Program is a comprehensive, pathway-based initiative designed to prepare youth for successful postsecondary transitions through three structured pathways: college prep, entrepreneurship, or trades workforce development. The program equips participants with practical skills, mentorship, and hands-on experiences that support informed decision-making, economic mobility, and long-term career success.

Participants will receive access to opportunities & resources. Girls on a Mission with Ambition drives action by empowering young women through training, mentorship, and transformative real-world experiences. Achievement is cultivated by supporting participants in earning credentials, accessing college pathways, securing meaningful employment, or launching sustainable businesses that strengthen their communities.

## FINANCIAL LITERACY FOR FUTURE LEADERS

Through our Financial Literacy for Future Leaders program, we educate and empower young girls on financial literacy and provide the tools needed to learn the basic fundamentals of money while helping them to become good stewards of their money. We partner with Financial Advisors, Banking Professionals and Entrepreneurs to educate girls on money management, savings, budgeting, streams of income, investing, entrepreneurship and more.

## THRIVING MINDS MENTAL HEALTH

We understand that Mental health is a critical aspect of overall well-being, especially for teens facing adversities. Through the “Thriving Minds Program,” we promote mental health awareness and partner with Mental Health Professionals to lead workshops, activities and lesson plans and create open forums for girls to talk openly about their mental health. We provide resources, support, and guidance to help girls navigate their emotions, cope with stress, and develop healthy coping mechanisms.
